NCP ON THE MOVE!

Since his installation and saddling with the affairs of GOFAMINT Students' Fellowship, the Student arm of The Gospel Faith Mission International at the last National Biennial Conference on Sunday 20th April 2025, Pastor Adebayo wasted no time hitting the ground running with series of visitations and Leadership/Empowerment Summit.

His first stop was at the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta (FUNAAB) on May 11, 2025, where he conducted the chapter's handing-over service. He was warmly received by Pastor Bode Oyela (Abeokuta Field Pastor) in the company of Pastor Gabriel Oyedele (Zonal Pastor, Abeokuta Zone 1), and Pastor Akinboro (Assistant Zonal Pastor, Abeokuta Zone 1). **

Continuing this stride, the NCP visited Tai Solarin University of Education (TASUED) on May 25, 2025, where he ministered on, "The Light". He charged both outgoing and incoming leaders to remain conscious of their identity as light in a dark world. The NCP was received by Pastor Wole Saseun (Ijebu/Remo Field Pastor), Pastor Dr. David Olaniyan (Ijebu Zone 1 Pastor), and Pastor Blessing Akinyelu (Assistant Zonal Pastor, Ijebu Zone 1). Notable GSF alumni in attendance included Pastor John Boye Adeyanju (GSF National Bible Study Secretary), Pastor Fisayo Osho (GSF Former National Music Director and Zonal Pastor, Ibadan Zone 2), and Pastor Mathew Poviesi (Zonal Pastor, liebu Zone 3).

Off the glimpse and the glamour of handing over services, on June 1, 2025, the tour moved to the Olabisi Onabanjo University Teaching Hospital (OOUTH), Sagamu, where Pastor Adebayo was received by the Field and Zonal Pastors.


A week later, on June 8, 2025, the NCP continued within the ljebu/Remo Field at Olabisi Onabanjo University, Ago-Iwoye Chapter, ministering on "Trust in the Lord." He was accompanied by Pastor Wole Saseun (Field Pastor), Pastor Segun Olatunji (Zonal Pastor), and Pastor Dare Ayegbusi (Assistant Zonal Pastor). The latest stop was a 2-day visit to Obafemi Awolowo University (OAU), Ile-Ife, the very pioneering GSF chapter where it all began over 43 years ago. Pastor Adebayo oversaw the Leadership Training as well as the Choice Sunday (handing-over service). Prior to praying for the new leadership to take the rein of leadership for the next one academic year, Pastor officially introduced and installed the Zonal Pastor, Pastor Dr. Kolapo Kayode and his Assistant as the Zonal Pastor for GSF in Ife Zone 1, comprising of the chapters at Obafemi Awolowo University (OAU), Osun State University (UNIOSUN) Ikire and the newly born Oduduwa University Ife (OUI).

The NCP came in the company of Pastor Segun Owolabi, GSF National Financial Secretary and was received by Pastor Dr. Abiodun Oyebola (the Interim Osun Field Pastor) alongside with Pastor Tolulope Oyelaran (National Evangelism Secretary and Zonal Pastor, Ilesha Zone 2)

It has been a packed yet purposeful itinerary for Pastor Adebayo, whose dedication to the spiritual health and growth of GSF chapters has been inspiring and impactful.
