WELCOME MESSAGE

Psalm 138:8

“The LORD will perfect that which concerns me; Your mercy, O LORD, endures forever; Do not forsake the works of Your hands.”

With the joy of Jesus Christ, I warmly welcome us into another year of God's faithfulness, a year loaded with divine opportunities, abundant blessings, and covenant promises. This season is specially significant for us as members of the **GOFAMINT Students' Fellowship (GSF)**.

Psalm 138 is a psalm of thanksgiving written by David, celebrating God's faithfulness, mercy, and unwavering commitment to His covenant. Verse 8 stands out as a powerful declaration of confidence in God's ability to complete every work He has begun in the lives of His people.

In a world marked by uncertainty, unfinished projects, broken plans, delayed dreams, and unmet expectations. Psalm 138:8 reassures us that our lives are not abandoned projects in God's hands. What concerns us concerns God, and He is fully committed to bringing His work in us, and in GSF, to completion.

Key Truths from Psalm 138:8

1. “The LORD will perfect that which concerns me.”

To *perfect* means to complete, fulfill, mature, and finish successfully. David declares that God is not only a starter but a finisher.

Philippians 1:6 “Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.”

Our destiny is not in the hands of chance, circumstances, or opposition. God Himself has taken responsibility for everything that concerns us, our calling, family, health, academics, ministry, career, and spiritual growth.

2. “That which concerns me.”

This phrase reveals God's personal interest in our lives:

- God is involved in the specific details of our lives.
- Nothing about us is too small or insignificant to Him.

Matthew 6:32–33 “Your heavenly Father knows that you have need of all these things... Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”

If it concerns us, it concerns God. He is neither distant nor indifferent to our struggles.

3. “Your mercy, O LORD, endures forever.”

David anchors his confidence not in his strength or consistency, but in God's enduring mercy.

Lamentations 3:22–23 “It is of the LORD’s mercies that we are not consumed... They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.”

God’s mercy does not expire, does not depend on human performance, and outlives our failures. Even when we stumble, mercy sustains God’s work in our lives until completion.

4. “Do not forsake the works of Your hands.”

David concludes with a humble prayer, acknowledging total dependence on God.

Isaiah 64:8 – “We are the clay, and You, our potter; we are all the work of Your hand.”

We are God’s workmanship His creation and His project. God never abandons what He creates; He finishes what He forms.

Important Reminders for All Chapters, Zones, and Fields

- God is a Finisher, not an abandoner.
- Our chapters, zones, and fields are divine assignments.
- Mercy sustains God’s projects.
- Faith declares completion before manifestation.
- Total dependence on God is essential for fulfillment.
- Trust God even when the process seems slow.
- Stop worrying about unfinished areas. God is still working.
- Declare God’s Word over your life and projects daily.
- Pray with confidence, not fear.

As we trust God with every detail of our lives, we remain confident that He will not abandon the work of His hands, specially the work of the **GOFAMINT Students’ Fellowship**.

We therefore align with the Anchor and Faith Declaration of our father in the Lord, **Pastor (Dr.) E. O. Abina**, the General Overseer of The Gospel Faith Mission International, boldly declares that in GSF:

- The Lord will perfect all that concerns us.
- Every incomplete project receives divine completion.
- GSF will not be abandoned midway in its destiny
- Mercy will speak loudly on our behalf.

GOFAMINT Students' Fellowship (GSF), formerly known as Gospel Students' Fellowship, stands as the vibrant students' ministry of The Gospel Faith Mission International (GOFAMINT). Since 1982, GSF has marched forward with a burning passion to transform lives, raise godly giants, and shine the light of Christ across Nigeria's academic landscape.

From the beginning, our mission has remained clear and compelling. GSF continues to:

- Pilot the spiritual growth of GOFAMINT students in a challenging and morally polluted academic world.
- Promote academic emancipation among students in both secondary and tertiary institutions.
- Champion academic excellence and intellectual discipline among Christian students.
- Strengthen godly social relationships and nurture interpersonal, professional, and marital values rooted in Scripture.

GSF began its inspiring journey at the then University of Ife (now Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife), Osun State, Nigeria. From that humble beginning, the Fellowship grew phenomenally into a sycamore tree of hope—offering spiritual depth, academic liberation, and social strength to generations of young people.

Today, GSF reaches nearly 100 tertiary institutions across Nigeria. Our National Secretariat sits at the International Office of GOFAMINT at Gospel City, Ogunmakin, Ogun State.

By God's grace, GSF has produced thousands of graduates who now serve as influential leaders in ministry, academia, business, government, engineering, medicine, and many other sectors. The Fellowship has consistently raised men and women who carry excellence, integrity, and the fire of God into their fields.

As GSF expanded, the Mission recognized the need for strong central leadership. In 1987, GOFAMINT appointed Evangelist R. O. Usenu as the first National Coordinating Minister. He served faithfully for 17 impactful years. In 2004, Pastor Richard Ologbonyo succeeded him and led with distinction for another 13 years before moving on to a fresh divine assignment.

In 2017, during the 17th Biennial Conference, the Fellowship embraced a historic rebranding—from Gospel Students’ Fellowship to GOFAMINT Students’ Fellowship (GSF). The new name aligned our identity with the global recognition of the Mission. In the same year, GOFAMINT reorganized the Youth and Students’ Ministries and created the Office of the Head of Youth/Corpers and GSF. Pastor Dr. (Engr.) Tunde Ojo, a former National President and a seasoned District and Regional Pastor, stepped into this leadership assignment.

Also in 2017, the title *National Coordinating Minister (NCM)* changed to *National Campus Pastor (NCP)*. Pastor (Prof.) Moses Aderibigbe became the pioneer holder of this new office, working with Field Pastors and the National Executive Committee (NEC). At the 2025 Biennial National Conference, he successfully handed over the mantle to Pastor Taiwo Olushola Adebayo as the new National Campus Pastor.

GSF continues to break barriers, overcome challenges, and advance with steady, strong, and unstoppable momentum. With almost 100 thriving chapters across Nigeria, we remain confident in God for greater open doors both nationwide and across the world.

GSF stands today as a family, a vision, a movement, and a spiritual powerhouse raising godly leaders for global impact.

CAPITAL PROJECTS

Several capital projects are currently on-going in almost all Campuses. This has become necessary because of the hostile treatment from the various schools' authorities. In some campuses, Fellowship activities are not allowed at all, while those that allows restrict their time of worship ridiculously to as little as 1 hour! Some were even harassed with their guest speakers.

The above trend has therefore motivated Fellowships to look for landed property and start building structures around the campuses. This somewhat is a plus to these Fellowship as they can hold programmes freely without any molestation from their schools' authorities. This move is however capital intensive as some of our students have to release even their school fees sometimes to get land or start building project.

As a way of encouraging these students, the Gospel Faith Mission International (GOFAMINT) has commenced an interventionist scheme of assisting all the campuses depending on the nature of their need.

In 2013: a sum ₦1.2 million was released to urgently rescue the following campuses:

Efforts are however on-going to get our Alumni mobilized in sponsoring both National programmes, projects and assist in students' welfare as well. The 40th anniversary project of GSF, which is the Student Center at the Gospel City, Ogunmakin is also to be supported.
